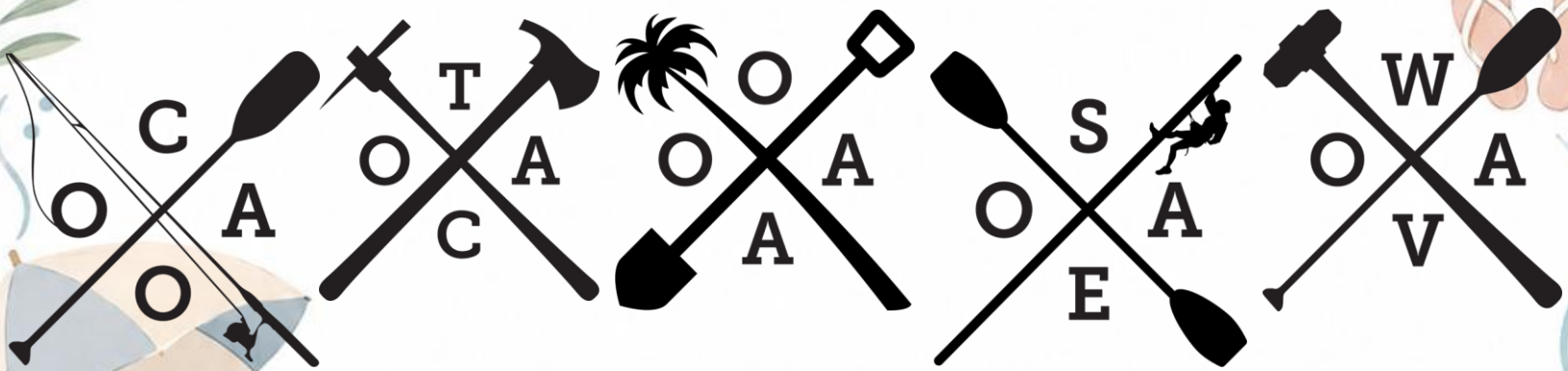
Mark your calendars for November 13–15, 2026, and join us for a weekend of growth, connection, and inspiration that will leave a lasting impact.
